- 5) Favorite Bible verse or story? **The story of Joseph**



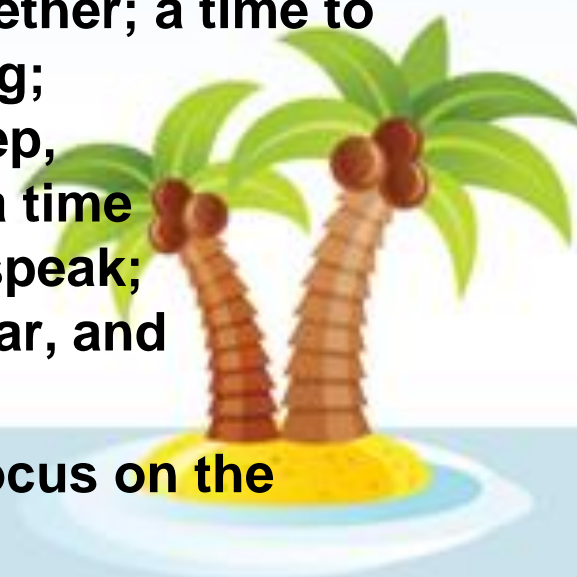
6) Name a funny word or phrase that Chad says or vice versa. **Chad's favorite saying is "What the Sam hill's going on"**
